Hema urges PM to develop Braj region

Mathura: Movie actor-turned-politician Hema Malini held discussions with Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Thursday with an aim to raise the profile of the Braj region, which attracts millions of devotees every year.

A source close to the MP said the 66-year-old, during her talks with the PM, focused on ways to develop the religious shrines associated with the Sri Krishna-Radha lore and various tourist spots in Braj Mandal, besides formulating ways to conserve the cultural heritage of the region.

Similar to Malini's earlier meeting with the PM in June this year, she again underlined the need to have a Yamuna cleaning project on the lines of the Ganga project. She also suggest that natural gas is provided to local industries at concessional rates.

Speaking to TOI, Hema Malini said that she was doing "her best" in promoting and conserving the region. "I have handed him (the Prime Minister) a list of 20-odd demands, and he has promised to take prompt action," she said, before underscoring her ambition to make the twin cities of Mathura and Vrindavan to be a "shining jewel" in the country.

Admitting that constraints will persist, she said that she was "actively involved" with the local administrators. She also expressed the urgent need to clean up the mess prevalent throughout the Braj area. "We have to begin with cleaning up the mess. A pledge will be taken on Friday morning by local citizens to keep Vrindavan clean and green," she added.

MP Malini also met with the farmers of Gokul area, days after an agitation had broken into scuffles with the police. The farmers, who are yet to get compensation from the government for the last 16 years, expressed their frustration over the long-gestating issue.

Malini has vowed to look into the matter.
